Located in the village of Bumwalukani, our Arlington Junior School (AJS) provides quality primary school education to 350 children. Our rigorous, traditional curriculum in English (Uganda's official language) emphasizes science, social studies, reading, and math. Our Ugandan teachers encourage participation, debate, critical thinking, and self-expression. In addition, students learn music, dance, drama, agriculture, domestic care, ecology, sports, and handicrafts.

OUR REACH



Since Arlington Junior School opened, REACH's sponsorship program has matched AJS students with sponsoring families from the US. We are proud that so many of our primary school students pass Uganda's Primary Learning Exam (PLE) and proceed to secondary and post-secondary education. Attendance in these programs is prohibitively expensive for the students, so we truly appreciate your help in supporting their opportunities and future successes. Sponsorship covers a student's tuition, uniform, meals, supplies, as well as healthcare.

OUR RESULTS



AJS delivers not only hope for a better future but also results. Every year, 100% of AJS students pass the Primary Leaving Exam (PLE), the national exam taken by all Ugandan students at the end of primary school. As a result, every AJS student has advanced to secondary school – a striking contrast to other local children. Our sponsors continue to support their students through their secondary and tertiary education, and many of our alumni return to AJS to serve as staff or teachers.

PRIMARY SPONSORSHIP PROVIDES



A MODEL EDUCATION

Our program emphasizes science, social studies, reading, and math. Our staff of Ugandan teachers, many of whom are school alumni, are well-trained and dedicated to their students and teaching. They give up modern conveniences of city life to live in this remote mountain village to teach our students.

EXTRACIRRICULAR

Students are encouraged to participate in debate, critical thinking, and self-expression as well as extra-curricular activities including music, drama, agriculture, domestic care, ecology, sports, and handicrafts. Our school also has a sports field where students can practice and play.





UNIFORM AND SUPPLIES

Each year, students receive a school uniform and athletic wear. Classrooms and library shelves are stocked with curriculum textbooks and a wide range of fiction and non-fiction materials. We strive to maintain a ratio of one textbook for every two students or better.

DAILY MEALS

Many students come to school hungry, which makes learning nearly impossible. With a free and daily mid-morning snack and lunch, our program nourishes children to help them focus on their studies.





HEALTHCARE

Good health is central to a child's long-term success, which is why tuition fees include healthcare. Our students have access to quality, reliable health services including immunizations and preventative care.

COMPUTER LAB

The library contains a computer lab with reliable internet access for students to dive into the world of computers. Our computer lab is expanding so we can provide distance learning so each child can continue their studies and explore new course content offered globablly.





LETTER EXCHANGES

One of the highlights during the school year are the letter exchanges between students and sponsors. Sponsors provide personal attention and moral encouragement by exchanging letters and photos. Many sponsors even participate in our annual trips to Uganda and meet their student(s)!
