## Teacher Trip

*Trip Dates: **March 29 - April 8***

Led by Marymount University Professor Dr. Elizabeth Langran, this trip offers teachers and adults with a background in education the opportunity to work with REACH's schools. Teachers are engaged in bringing active learning strategy workshops to teachers at REACH and local outreach schools. They also have time to volunteer in the classrooms at Arlington Junior School or Matuwa Junior School and have an afternoon home visit.

### Program Details

Trip participants will

- be part of a collaborative team to **develop and deliver teacher workshops** at Arlington Junior School and outreach schools
- volunteer in classrooms and **mentor teachers** in active learning strategies
- participate in an afternoon **home visit** with a Ugandan student

In-country private travel and stay (food and lodging) at the guest house will be included with program fees.

## Adult & Family Trip

*Trip Dates: **June 28 - July 13***

This yearly trip, open to adults and families, is led by REACH Board President and former Uganda Peace Corps Volunteer, Dick Burk and his wife, Carole. The Adult & Family trip is a great way to experience and understand AAH's operations in Uganda by spending time volunteering at REACH's schools and health clinics, visiting the families of sponsored students, and touring AAH outreach schools.

This trip includes a chance to see the beauty of Uganda through excursions, such as whitewater rafting or an environmental cruise on the Nile, hiking Sipi Falls, taking land and river safaris in Murchison Falls National Park, going rhino tracking, and visiting Kampala. An evening lecture on the history of Uganda and its peoples will be enjoyed by all.

The Adult & Family trip includes:

- A chaperone/guide throughout the trip
- In-country, private **transportation**
- 24/7 volunteer support
- **Upgraded** accommodations
- Most meals
- Visits to the homes of **sponsored students**
- **Guided hikes** (walk) through 300 foot Sipi Falls
- Two excursions on the Nile, game drives on **safari** in Murchison Falls National Park, **rhino tracking**
- Visits to Kampala (Uganda's capital) and Jinja (source of the Nile)
- A mountain gorilla trek can be included
- Trip insurance

## Teen Service Trip

*Trip Dates: **July 17 - August 5***

Each year, REACH for Uganda offers a chaperoned Teen Service Trip to give students the opportunity to visit our programs and volunteer at our schools and clinics in Uganda. This trip is only for teens (ages 14-18) and limited to 12 teen participants.

Traveling with REACH to Uganda is an opportunity to travel and stay in Africa at a relatively low cost while contributing to a meaningful, life changing program. Our teens engage in several service opportunities including:

- Volunteering at our **primary schools**, Arlington Junior School (AJS) & Matuwa Junior School, interacting with students, teachers, and staff
- Kicking off the Arlington Traditional School Reading Challenge their sister school, AJS
- Volunteering at Matuwa Junior School, which is sister school to Nottingham and Tuckahoe Elementary
- Volunteering at the two Beatrice Tierney **Health Clinics**
- Visiting **outreach schools** and interacting with their students
- Mentoring students through games, activities, and meaningful conversations
- Going to visit your sponsored student's home (optional & chaperoned)
- Visiting with AAH secondary students at a select school
- Engaging in various **sightseeing** activities such as climbing Mt. Nusu, Namisindwa Hill, Buraba and Larso Falls, hiking Sipi Falls, visiting the Source of the Nile River, and **going on a land and water safari** in Murchison Falls National Park.

*To secure your spot on this trip, a nonrefundable deposit of \$500 is due before January 31, 2023. The deposit goes towards the total trip cost of \$3,100 per teen. All meals, accommodations, in country transportation, and safari are included. [Click here to join!](#)*

## Work Trip

*Trip Dates: **July 28 - August 28***

This special trip is led by REACH co-founder and director, John Wanda. This trip offers adults (age 25+) wishing to stay longer in the villages REACH impacts to work on a meaningful project at AAH schools, clinics or in the community. Participants can leave early or even chose to stay longer.

The trip will be about one month, though it is flexible. Participants are able to choose their own dates, and stay for as long or as little as they choose. The goal of the work trip is twofold: first, we want participants to determine a meaningful project with John that they will have time to carry out and second, we want volunteers to be able to fully immerse themselves in the culture/activities of the village.
