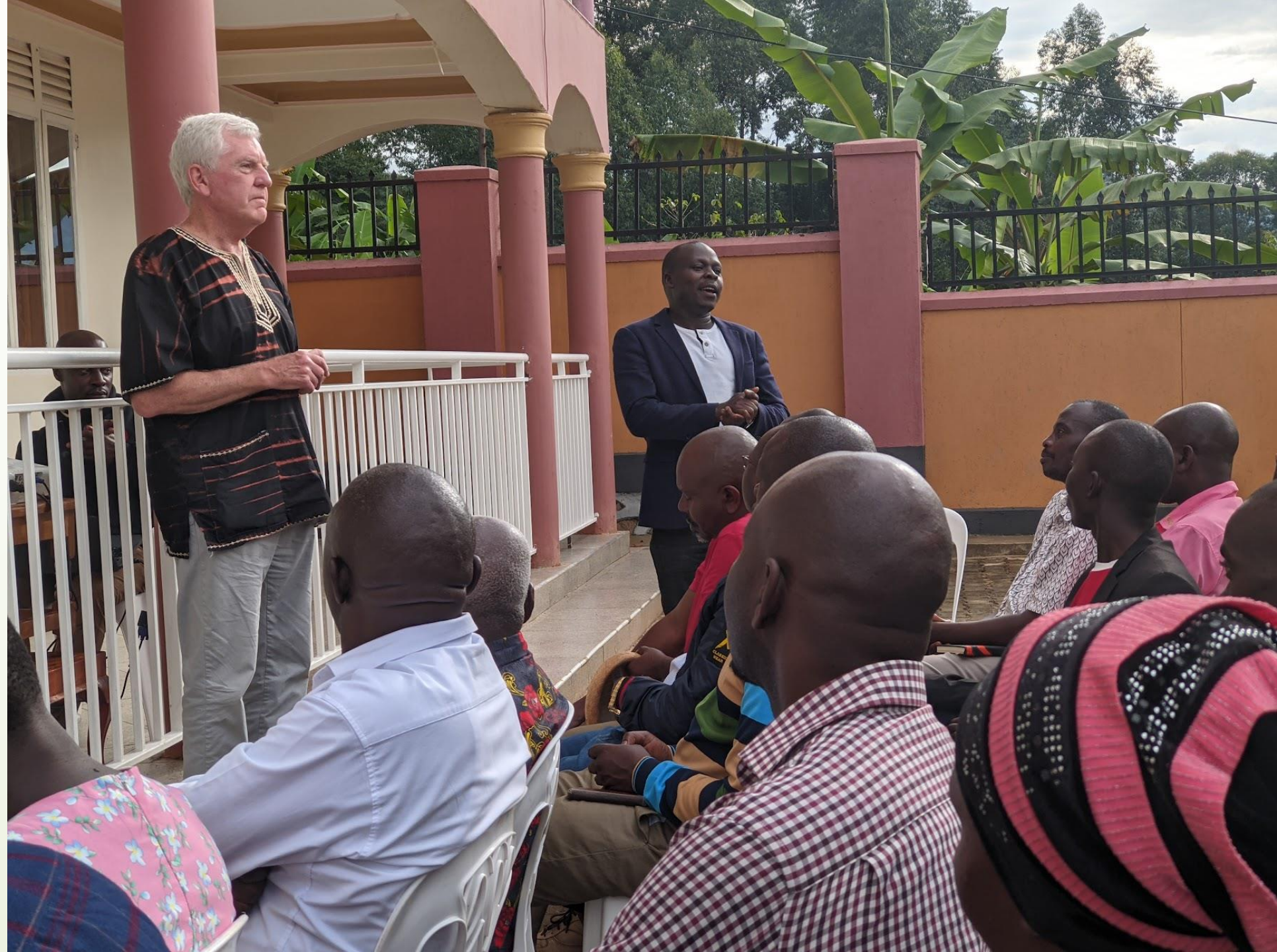

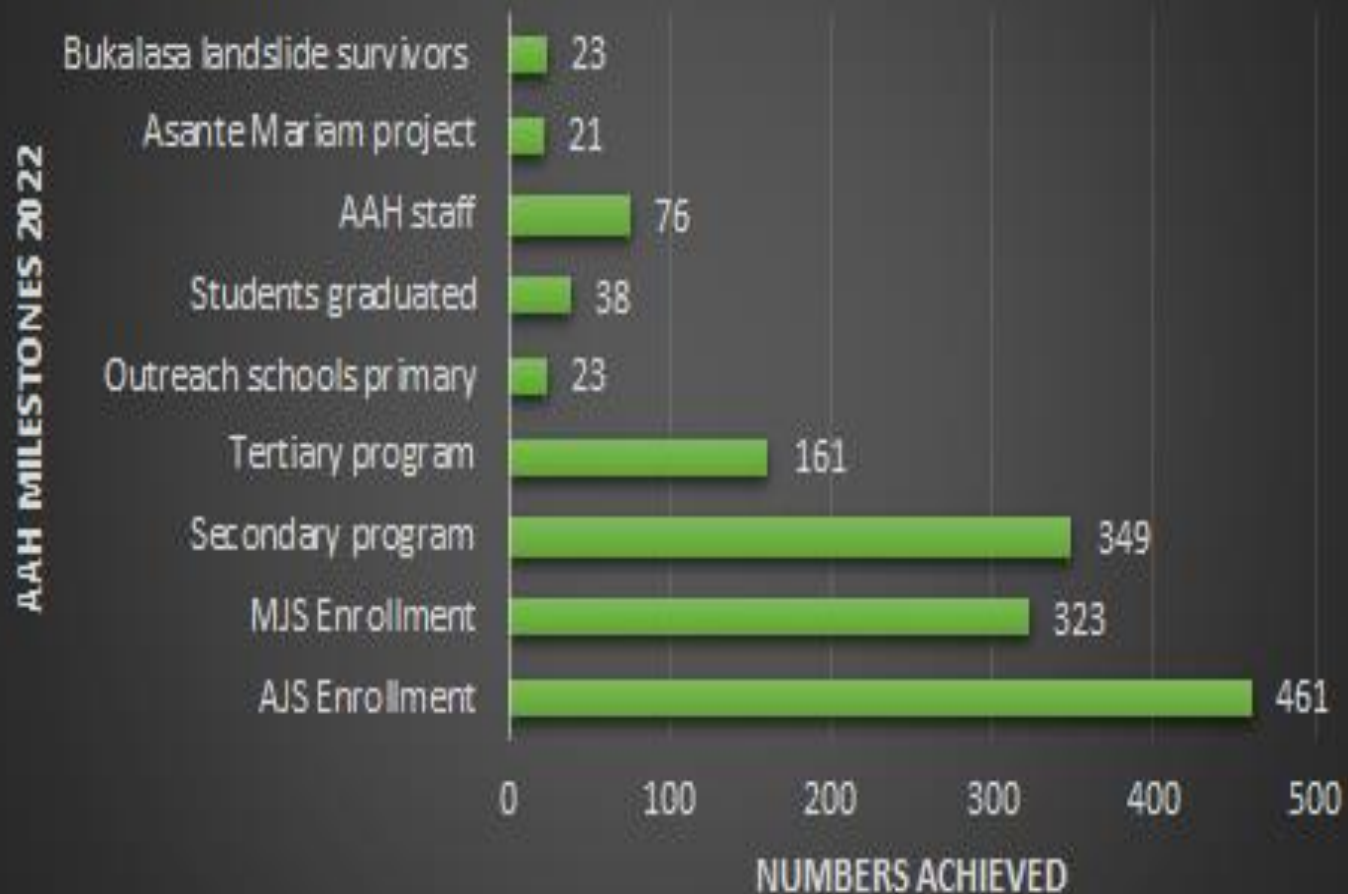

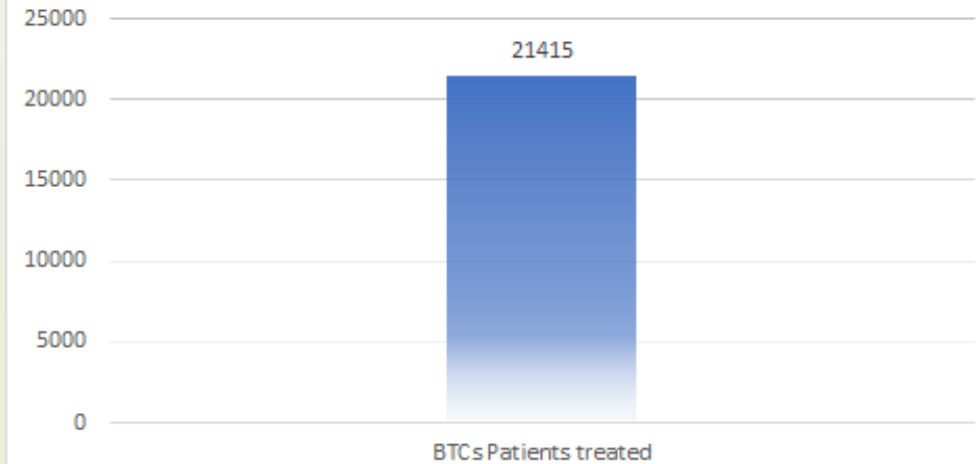


AAH Milestone Dashboard 2022

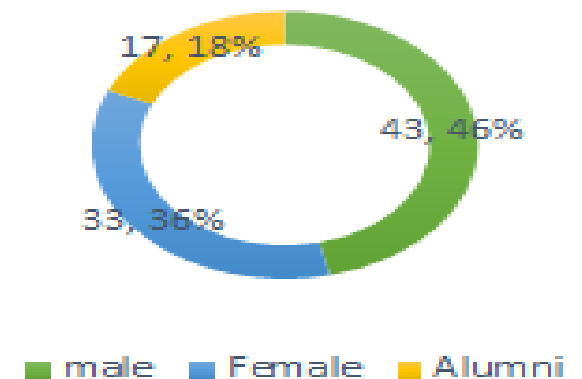
AAH Milestones statistics



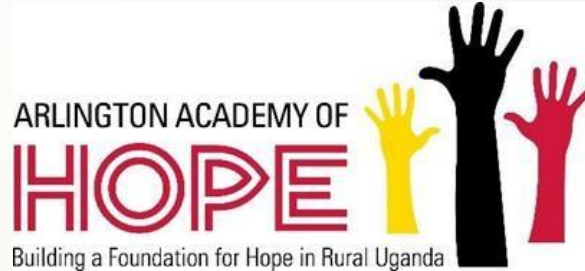
BTC CLIENTS REACHED IN YR 2022
