The library was made possible by the children of Marianne and Jeremy Rusk and their families in honor of their parents Marianne and Jeremy Rusk. Jeremy was a college professor and administrator. He retired from Harvard University as an Assistant Dean. His wife Marianne worked for many years at Tufts University in Boston where she was the first woman Vice President. She also worked at the Getty Museum in Los Angeles.



The library will serve students at Matuwa Junior School and others in the surrounding Community in Namisindwa district. We are grateful to the Rusk family for their generous donations that have allowed us to complete the building and provide furniture. Their

parents legacy will be felt for generations to come in this community. Efforts are now underway to stock the library. We're in need of computers, Internet access for our computer lab, solar panels for lighting and books for all levels. We have received many donations of books from our partner schools in the US that we would like to ship to Uganda.
