

Arlington Secondary School Construction Progress



Construction of the AAH Secondary and Vocational School continues this month, with walling, initial installation of windows and doors, and plans for roofing. The classroom block is the more advanced at this time, with walling of the third floor almost complete. The boy's dormitory is at the second-floor slab, while the girls dormitory is still at second floor walling. All three buildings will be roofed by the end of March, whereafter the complicated details of mechanical and electric works, plumbing, plastering, and final finishes begin.

Our funding needs as we enter this critical phase of construction are acute. We need to buy materials for all finishes, including electrical and mechanical. We need to ensure all windows and doors are in place. Above all, we need to ensure that the overall construction program is on schedule. Any delays cost us labor hours, and backlogs cascade and create scheduling challenges. We need your help to keep this project going and to ensure that the school will open on February 2025 as planned. We invite you to be part of this project.
